As an organization composed of students at the Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at the University at Buffalo, community health workers, and physicians, the Lighthouse Free Medical Clinic provides free healthcare to the uninsured and underserved patients of Buffalo, NY. As the only medical student body in the area, we undertake this work to provide a service to the community in which we are educated. In addition, we hope to encourage a long-term, professional interest in community health in medical students and other health professions students who gain experience at our clinic. We aim to re-mediate some of the barriers to healthy living and access to preventive medical care in underserved communities. In the pursuit of this goal, we provide resources to help connect uninsured patients with the means to access continuous medical care and education about healthy lifestyle choices and disease prevention to encourage health literacy. We hope to provide these services in a partnership with the members of the community in which we work by building long-term, mutually beneficial relationships, so that we can best serve the unique needs of our specific patient population.

A backstory on the Lighthouse Free Medical Clinic: In January 2001, the Black Leadership Forum of Buffalo reported that 43.00% of Buffalo residents live below the poverty line. 16.00% of patients had difficulty paying for their health care, and over 20.00% had difficulty paying for prescriptions. These statistics reflected the need for additional, accessible health care services on the East Side of Buffalo, NY. To address the health care needs of this patient population, two students at the Jacobs School of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at the University at Buffalo established the Lighthouse Free Medical Clinic in 2001. Since then, the clinic has flourished, and provides uninsured and low-income individuals with free health care services, supported by a volunteer staff of local physicians, residents, medical students, and undergraduate students. The clinic is open every Friday from 5:00 PM to 10:00 PM, during which we see up to 20 patients. Patients are offered insurance counseling/enrollment, chronic illness education, blood pressure checks, blood glucose readings, basic blood work, PPDs for tuberculosis screening, pregnancy tests, and testing for STIs. Lighthouse provides a valuable service to an underserved community by empowering patients through access to medical and social services and working to connect them to more stable health care. We achieve this by working with an interdisciplinary team of physicians, social workers, nutritionists, law specialists, and more. With growing interest and support, we have been able to expand our services to offer patients dermatology, gynecology, dental, public health, social work, law, and nutrition.
